The current news:

(1) The *OfS V Special Issue of MDPI Remote Sensing* is nearing its completion. Out of the 10 papers selected for this Special Issue, 6 have been published already, 2 are currently being processed, while the last 2 will be submitted shortly. We aim to finalize this project in 2024 (see www.mdpi.com/journal/remotesensing/special_issues/N5M29MQT28).

(2) The *Pillars of Hercules Foundation* is planning an International Workshop, to be held in Venice in 2025, titled "*The Pillars of Hercules: A Mediterranean MOSE?*" and focusing on climate change, sea level rise and the fate of coastal sites in the Venice class.
